Weekend Closure of Main Street in Corona Set for October 23-26, 2015

As part of the 91 Project in Corona, weekend full closures of the Main Street roadway will occur the weekend of October 23 to lower and widen the roadway beneath the 91.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, which is the lead agency for the project, noted that Main Street will be closed in both directions between Grand Boulevard and Fourth Street from 7 pm on Friday, October 23 to 4 am on Monday, October 26.

Motorists should follow all posted detours; please see map on page 2. The Grand Boulevard westbound on-ramp and eastbound off-ramp will remain open throughout the closure.

Please allow extra travel time, watch for signs and rideshare whenever possible. Metrolink train riders should allow additional time to and from the North Main Corona Station. Please remember to patronize local businesses and use the “Shop 91. Shop Local.” section of the website for coupon deals.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express lane connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
