Full Weekend Closures Planned for Main Street and 91 in Corona for Bridge Demolition

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project, full closures will occur on the Main Street undercrossing and on the 91 in this area November 14-16 to allow crews to demolish sections of the bridge. The work will occur for 36 hours and will include:

Full closure of southbound Main Street at the 91	Friday at 9 p.m. - Sunday at 9 a.m.
Full closure of northbound Main Street between Third Street and the 91	Friday at 9 p.m. - Sunday at 9 a.m.
Full closure of eastbound 91 lanes at Main Street	Saturday at 11:59 p.m. - Sunday at 6 a.m.
Full closure of eastbound 91 on-ramp at Main Street	Friday at 9 p.m. - Sunday at 9 a.m. (Ramp will be open from Saturday at 11:59 pm to Sunday at 6 pm during the full closure of the eastbound lanes)
Northbound 15 to westbound 91 Interchange	Friday at 10 p.m. - Saturday at 6:30 a.m.

Motorists will be detoured to Sixth Street, Lincoln Avenue and Railroad Street during this work. Lane closures also will occur on westbound and eastbound 91 near Main Street from Friday night to Saturday morning, but no detours are necessary, as other lanes will remain open.

The closures are necessary to allow crews to safely demolish a portion of the widening of the 91 and to remove an overhead sign structure. Noise can be expected with these activities.

“With Thanksgiving just around the corner, this weekend gives us an opportunity to complete a lot of work while minimizing the inconvenience to a much shorter time period,” said Corona Mayor Karen Spiegel who also serves as an RCTC Commissioner. “Safety is our first priority so I urge everyone to plan ahead and be informed so we can work together to ensure a successful project for our community and anyone else who visits Corona.”
