Open House to Spotlight Upcoming Construction Work on 91 Project

Residents, business operators and commuters are invited to attend an Open House on June 19 to learn more about upcoming construction activity on the 91 Project in Corona and Riverside.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, which is the lead agency for the 91 Project, will host the Open House from 6 pm to 8 pm at the Corona Public Library, 650 S. Main Street, Corona. The 91 Project will add regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express lane connectors between the 91 and Interstate 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps and surface streets also will be made along the 91 corridor between the Riverside County/Orange County Line and Pierce Street in Riverside.

Crews began early construction activities this year, including tree clearing, property demolition, utility relocation, railroad realignment and soil sampling. Full construction is planned to begin in July, and the new lanes are estimated to open by 2017.

The Open House meeting format will allow visitors to drop by at their convenience between 6 pm to 8 pm to talk to project team members, view exhibits and maps, see anticipated construction schedules and learn what to expect during construction. No formal presentation is scheduled during the Open House.
