Corona: Daytime Closures of N. Main Street Roadway, Ramps Set for Feb. 21-22

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona will require daytime closures of the 91 Main Street on-ramps and off-ramps and a section of N. Main Street on Tuesday, Feb. 21 and Wednesday, Feb. 22. The roadway will be closed between Fourth Street and Grand Boulevard from 9 am to 7 pm both days for repaving and temporary striping.

Although weekday ramp and road closures typically are conducted at night for the 91 Project, this work must be performed during warmer daytime hours, since nighttime temperatures are forecasted to be too cold for paving to occur.

During the closures, access will be maintained to local businesses, and flaggers will be on site to guide motorists through the closures. Motorists should allow extra travel time, follow posted detour routes, patronize local businesses, share this information with friends and colleagues, and check real-time traffic information using IE511.org. In the event of rain, work will take place the next available day. Work will include:

- **Tuesday, Feb. 21 – Northbound N. Main Street, Eastbound 91 Main Street On-Ramp and Westbound 91 Main Street Off-Ramp** – Southbound Main Street will have only one lane open, as other lanes will be used to place equipment and materials and to maintain a safe work area for crews. To access businesses on the east side of N. Main Street, motorists may use Third Street or Fourth Street. Motorists may use E. Grand Blvd or W. Grand Blvd to travel north and may use the Lincoln Avenue ramps.
- **Wednesday, Feb. 22 – Southbound N. Main Street, Eastbound 91 Main Street Off-Ramp, and Westbound 91 Main Street On-Ramp** –Northbound Main Street will have

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only one lane open, as other lanes will be used for work staging. To access businesses on the west side of Main Street, motorists may use Third Street. Motorists may use E. Grand Blvd or W. Grand Blvd to travel south and may use the Lincoln Avenue ramps.

Please note that additional daytime closures of local streets adjacent to the 91 are planned for paving and restriping in February and March.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also are being made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is more than 91 percent complete, and the new lanes are on schedule to open this spring.

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
