#### **Ramp, Road Closures to Occur near Maple Street for 91 Project in Corona**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's (RCTC) 91 Project in Corona will require several closures of ramps and roads near Maple Street this weekend for bridge construction and intersection paving. Closures include:

- **Full closure of the eastbound 91 Maple Street off-ramp:** Friday, Dec. 9 at 9 pm to Monday, Dec. 12 at 4 am. As a detour, motorists may use the eastbound 91 Serfas Club/Auto Center off-ramp or the Lincoln Avenue off-ramp. This closure is to support paving operations at the Sixth Street/Paseo Grande intersection.
- **Full closure of the westbound 91 Maple Street on-ramp and Maple Street Bridge:** Saturday, Dec. 10 at 9 pm to Sunday, Dec. 11 at 5 am. Please note that this will result in the closure of two consecutive westbound on-ramps, since the westbound Lincoln Avenue on-ramp is closed for two months. Motorists can use the westbound Main Street on-ramp or the Serfas Club/Auto Center on-ramp as detours. These closures are required for crews to pour concrete for the new Maple Street Bridge.
- **Full closure of westbound Sixth Street at Paseo Grande:** Friday, Dec. 9 at 9 pm to Monday, Dec. 12 at 4 am. To access Shell, Denny's and Carl's Jr. or to enter westbound 91 at Maple Street, motorists will need to travel south over the Maple Street Bridge from Pomona Road. Motorists can use Serfas Club Drive/Auto Center Drive or Smith Street north to Pomona Road and head toward Maple Street. Motorists exiting these businesses will be required to go west from Shell, Denny's and Carl's Jr. and to enter westbound 91. Note that access will not be available during bridge work noted above.

Next weekend will bring more work to this Sixth Street/Paseo Grande intersection, weather permitting.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will

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be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is on schedule to open new lanes by spring 2017.
