**Nighttime Full Closures of 91 in Corona to Continue in June**  
***Eastbound 91 at Maple Street: **June 3*****  
***Westbound 91 at Maple Street: **June 4** for approximately three weeks***  
***Eastbound 91 at I-15: **June 4** for approximately four weeks***

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project will require a series of nighttime full closures of the 91 in Corona continuing tonight and through June. The closures are needed for ongoing work at the new Maple Street Bridge, the westbound 91 Maple Street on-ramp bridge, and the tolled direct connector between the 91 and Interstate 15.

The nighttime closure schedule follows. Please note that lane reductions will occur about one hour prior to the full closures at these locations.

- 1. Eastbound 91 Full Closure at Maple Street – **June 3**, 10 pm to 5 am.** Motorists will exit at Maple Street and reenter eastbound 91 at Paseo Grande.
- 2. Westbound 91 Full Closure at Maple Street – Starting **June 4** for approximately three weeks. See closure times below.** Motorists will exit at Maple Street and re-enter westbound 91 at Auto Center Drive/Serfas Club Drive.
  - **Monday-Thursday nights – 9 pm to 4 am nightly**
  - **Friday nights – 10 pm to 7 am**
  - **Saturday nights – 10 pm to 7:30 am**
- 3. Eastbound 91 Full Closure at I-15 – Starting **June 4** for approximately four weeks. See closure times below.** Motorists will travel south on the 15, exit Magnolia Avenue and use northbound 15 to reenter eastbound 91. The eastbound 91/northbound 15 connector and the southbound 15/eastbound 91 connector also will be closed.

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- **Monday-Thursday nights – 10 pm to 5 am nightly**
- **Friday nights – midnight to 7:30 am**
- **Saturday nights – midnight to 8:30 am**

During these closures and throughout construction, motorists are reminded to adhere to the posted speed limit within the 91 Project construction zone, allow extra travel time, follow detour signs, and carpool, when feasible. Construction work is subject to change based on weather or other factors.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
