6-Hour Closure of Eastbound 91 at Maple Street Set for April 10; 36-Hour Lane Closure of Westbound 91 Postponed

As part of the 91 Project in Corona, the Riverside County Transportation Commission will require a six-hour closure of eastbound 91 at Maple Street early Sunday morning, April 10, from 12:01 am to 6 am to allow crews to work on the temporary support structure for the Maple Street bridge and to place an overhead sign structure near Lincoln Avenue. This work is subject to weather conditions.

Motorists will exit the eastbound 91 at Maple Street, use Sixth Street to connect to El Sobrante Road, and then head south on Magnolia Avenue to enter northbound Interstate 15 to reconnect to the 91. Detour signs will be posted and motorists should allow extra travel time.

In addition, this weekend's previously planned closure of the far right lane on westbound 91 between the Green River Road on-ramp and the Riverside County/Orange County Line from April 8 at 9 pm to April 10 at 9 am has been postponed. Updated information about this lane closure will be provided next week.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
