E. Grand Blvd. to Remain Closed until Monday; 91 Project Work Suspended for Weekend

The East Grand Boulevard roadway will remain closed to motorists until Monday as the 91 Project team continues its investigation into the collapse of the temporary support beams that occurred Friday night at about 11 pm. All 91 Project work has been suspended until Monday.

The incident hospitalized nine workers, one of whom has been released. Eight workers remain hospitalized, with three in critical condition. The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) will announce any change to their conditions.

“RCTC is dedicated to the safety of the 91 Project and the men and women who are making these infrastructure improvements,” Executive Director Anne Mayer said. “Our thoughts and prayers are with these workers and their families.”

“We greatly appreciate the outpouring of well wishes from the public for our injured crew members. Please keep those positive messages flowing through social media, #91bridgeupdate and #sr91project,” Mayer said.
