Eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive Off-Ramp Weekend Closure

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) announces a full closure of the eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive off-ramp in Corona from 9 pm on Friday, September 18 through 4 am on Monday, September 21.

The ramp closure is part of the 91 Project's "Serfas Club/Maple Makeover" activity that began in June and will continue through late 2016. The closure will allow crews to continue reconfiguring the off-ramp for the widening of the 91. Ongoing activities in the area include full closures of the Serfas Club Drive eastbound 91 on-ramp and westbound 91 off-ramp, utility relocations and lanes reductions on Serfas Club.

As an alternate route, motorists can use the Maple Street/Paseo Grande off-ramp and the new Frontage Road alignment between Paseo Grande and Serfas Club Drive. Please see detour map on page 2.

During this time and throughout construction, motorists are reminded to obey the posted reduced 55 MPH within the 91 Project construction zone, allow extra travel time, especially to and from the West Corona Metrolink station, follow detour signs, adjust travel plans to off-peak hours, if possible, and to carpool or use public transit, when feasible. Remember to patronize local businesses and use the "Shop 91. Shop Local." section of the website for coupon deals.

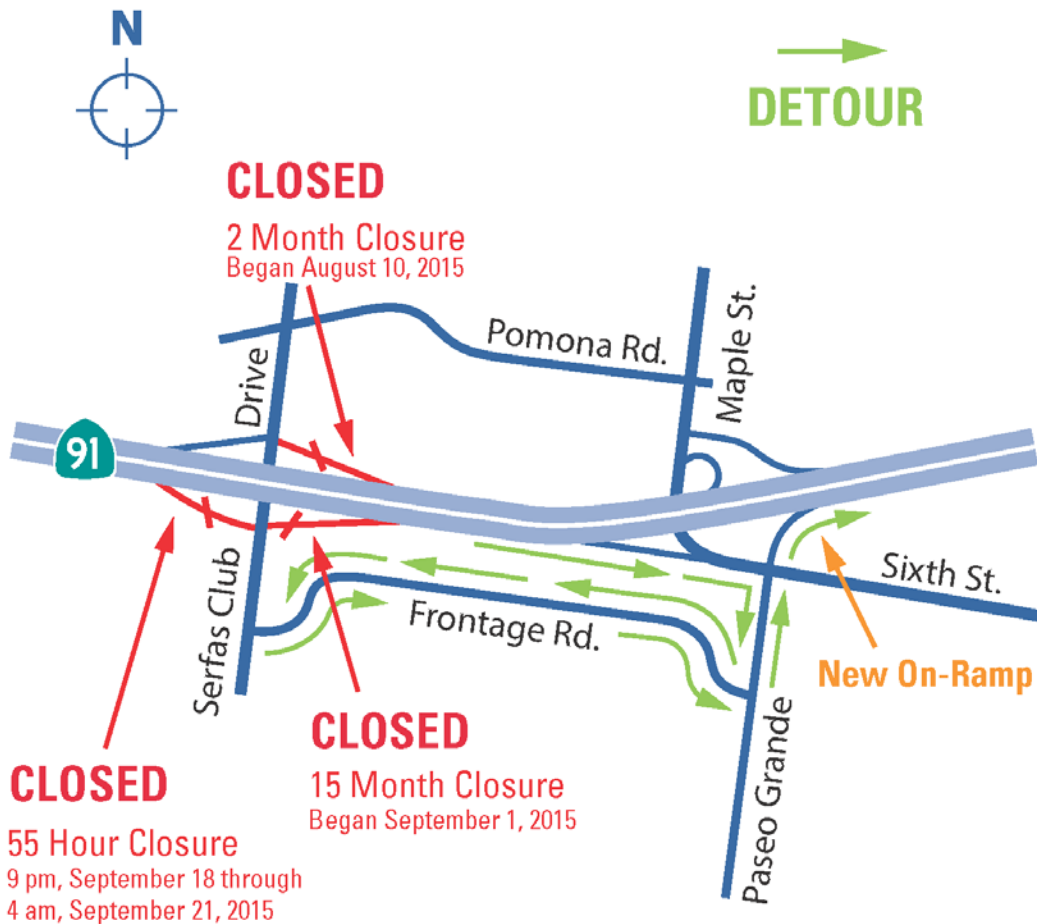

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express lane connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
