#### **Nightly Closures of Westbound 91 at Lincoln Avenue Set for Dec. 27-29**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona will require nighttime closures of westbound 91 at Lincoln Avenue in Corona, December 27-29, to allow crews to remove the temporary support structures from the Lincoln Avenue Bridge. Closures will occur nightly from 11 pm to 4 am with lane reductions beginning one to two hours in advance.

During the closures, motorists can use the westbound Lincoln Avenue off-ramp and immediately re-enter the 91 at the Lincoln Avenue on-ramp, which will open tonight. The new on-ramp will open with one lane, but will be expanded to its permanent configuration of three lanes in January 2017. Please note that a portion of Lincoln Avenue between Pomona Road and Second Street also will be closed, due to the work on the Lincoln Bridge.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is approximately 91 percent complete, and the new lanes are on schedule to open during the spring of 2017.
