#### **Weekend Closure Set for Section of Lincoln Avenue, Oct. 28-31**

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona, a weekend closure is needed to repave a section of Lincoln Avenue between Second/D Street and Fifth Street in Corona. The closure is scheduled from Friday, October 28 at 9 pm to Monday, October 31 at 4 am.

Motorists traveling south over the Lincoln Avenue bridge can access eastbound 91 or the Cardenas Shopping Center by heading east on Second Street. Access to westbound 91 from Lincoln Avenue will be available by traveling west on D Street to connect with Sixth Street. Motorists will be able to travel north over the Lincoln Avenue bridge from Second/D Street. Access to the eastbound 91 Lincoln Avenue on-ramp and off-ramp and the westbound 91 off-ramp will remain open to motorists during this closure.

Access to local businesses and residences will be permitted north of Fifth Street from Lincoln Avenue, with no access to Second Street or D Street. As alternate routes, motorists can use Smith Street, Buena Vista Avenue and Main Street to travel north of the 91.

The closure is subject to change, based on rain and other factors. Motorists who do not need to conduct business in this area should use alternate routes. Also, motorists should allow extra travel time and check real-time traffic information using [IE511.org](http://IE511.org).

Additional closures will be required for paving sections of Lincoln Avenue between Second Street and Pomona Road on future weekends in November.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are on schedule to open in the first half of 2017.
