Weekend Closures of the Eastbound 91 Lincoln Avenue Off-Ramp and Westbound 91 Lincoln Avenue On-Ramp, July 22-25

As part of the 91 Project in Corona, 55-hour closures of the eastbound 91 Lincoln Avenue off-ramp and the westbound 91 Lincoln Avenue on-ramp are planned from Friday, July 22 at 9 pm to Monday, July 25 at 4 am.

Eastbound 91 Lincoln Avenue Off-Ramp

This closure will allow crews to continue construction of the new ramp. As an alternate route, motorists can use the Main Street off-ramp, proceed north on Main Street, west on Grand Boulevard, and west on Railroad Street to connect to Lincoln Avenue; or head south at Main Street and west on Sixth Street to connect to Lincoln Avenue.

Westbound 91 Lincoln Avenue On-Ramp

This closure will allow crews to safely shift the temporary on-ramp and to continue widening the 91 and Pomona Road. The section of Pomona Road between Lincoln Avenue and Smith Avenue will be closed to through-traffic; local access will be provided. Westbound motorists can use the Main Street on-ramp as an alternate route via Sixth Street or Railroad Street/Grand Boulevard.

During these closures and throughout construction, drivers are reminded to adhere to the posted speed limit within the 91 Project construction zone, follow detour signs, and carpool, when feasible. Motorists are encouraged to allow extra travel time and to patronize area businesses. For real-time traffic information, go to IE511.org. These closures are subject to change based on weather or other factors.

- MORE -

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open the first half of 2017.
