#### **Corona: Weekend Closure of Sixth Street from Paseo Grande to Via Bernardo Set for Jan. 13-16**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona will require the closure of a section of Sixth Street between Paseo Grande and Via Bernardo to allow crews to repave this area. The closure will occur from Friday, January 13 at 9 pm to Monday, January 16 at 4 am, weather permitting. If rain occurs, work will be postponed to the next weekend.

Access will be provided to businesses on Sixth Street between Paseo Grande and Via Bernardo, but there will be no access through the intersection. Motorists heading north on Paseo Grande will be able to turn left on Sixth Street. Motorists heading east on Sixth Street must turn right and head south on Paseo Grande.

As a detour, motorists can use Pomona Road to the north of the 91 for east/west travel between Serfas Club Drive/Auto Center Drive and Smith Street.

Motorists should allow extra travel time, follow posted detour signs, share this information with friends and colleagues, and check real-time traffic information using [IE511.org](http://IE511.org). The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is approximately 91 percent complete, and the new lanes are on schedule to open during the spring of 2017.
