#### **“91 Steer Clear” Public Meeting set for Saturday, February 6**

Residents, business operators, and commuters are invited to attend a public meeting on Saturday, February 6 to learn about local impacts of the “**91 Steer Clear**” weekend full closure of the 91 that will occur Feb. 19-22 as part of the 91 Project in Corona.

The 55-hour closure of eastbound and westbound 91 will take place Friday, Feb. 19 at 9 pm to Monday, Feb. 22 at 4 am.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) will host the meeting from 9 am to noon at the Corona Public Library, 650 S. Main Street. Presentations will be held at 9:30 am, 10:30 am and 11:30 am; the presentation will be repeated. A webcast option will be available at 10:30 am for those who are unable to attend the meeting in person. RCTC is reminding motorists to plan ahead, avoid the area or stay home. During the closure, crews will consolidate three major construction activities:

- Demolish the west side of the Maple Street Bridge over the 91
- Install support beams for the new westbound Maple Street flyover ramp bridge
- Pave the new eastbound 91 alignment near I-15

In case of rainstorms or inclement weather, the Feb. 19-22 closure will be postponed to the next weekend, weather permitting.

Motorists traveling on the 91, the 71 or I-15 near the project area during the closure period can expect travel delays of three to four hours. If travel cannot be avoided, motorists can use the 57, 60 and I-10 as alternate routes.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
