Nightly Closures of Eastbound 91 at Maple Street Set for Nov. 3-5

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona will require nighttime closures of eastbound 91 at Maple Street in Corona, November 3-5, to allow crews to remove the temporary support structures from the new Maple Street Bridge.

This eastbound work previously was planned to start on November 4. However, crews are ahead of schedule to remove the temporary support structures from the westbound side of the bridge and plan to finish tonight, one day early. This will allow work to start on the eastbound side on November 3. Motorists traveling east on the 91 will use the Maple Street off-ramp and turn left at Paseo Grande to re-enter eastbound 91. Work is scheduled as follows:

- Wednesday, November 2 – Continued removal of temporary support structures at Maple Street Bridge, westbound 91, 10 pm to 4 am
- Thursday, November 3 – Removal of temporary support structures at Maple Street Bridge, eastbound 91, 10 pm to 5 am
- Friday, November 4 – Removal of temporary support structures at Maple Street Bridge, eastbound 91, 11 pm to 6 am
- Saturday, November 5 – Removal of temporary support structures at Maple Street Bridge, eastbound 91, 11:59 pm to 7:30 am

With changing conditions, motorists are asked to plan ahead, follow detour routes, allow extra travel time, share this information with friends and colleagues, and check real-time traffic information using IE511.org.

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The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is more than 85 percent complete, and the new lanes are on schedule to open during the first half of 2017.
