I-15 Connectors to Westbound 91 to be Closed Night of April 17 Lane Closures Planned on Westbound 91 for Roadway Paving

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project, the southbound and northbound Interstate 15 connectors to westbound 91 will be closed from Sunday, April 17 at 9 pm to Monday, April 18 at 4:30 am. This closure will allow crews to close several lanes on westbound 91 between I-15 and Main Street to restripe the roadway.

Westbound 91 travel will be reduced from four lanes to one lane beginning at 11 pm, with restriping starting on the north side of the roadway and then shifting to the south side. Motorists needing to access westbound 91 from I-15 can head east on the 91 and exit McKinley Street, turn left on McKinley and enter westbound 91. Motorists should allow extra travel time and watch for detour signs. In addition, motorists returning from the Coachella Festival in Indio are advised to avoid the area and use I-10 or State Route 60 as alternate routes.

Construction activities are subject to change based on weather and field conditions.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
