Consistent with other public meetings held by RCTC, during public comments, each individual speaker is limited to speak three (3) continuous minutes or less. Depending on the time remaining in the meeting, number of items on the agenda and number of speakers, the CCTF facilitator may waive this three-minute time limitation or reduce the time of each speaker to two (2) continuous minutes. In addition, the maximum time for public comment is thirty (30) minutes. Speakers may not yield their time to others without the consent of the CCTF facilitator. Any written documents to be distributed or presented to the CCTF shall be submitted to the CCTF facilitator.

The CCTF, as an advisory task force of citizens, is not subject to Brown Act regulations. Meeting agendas and minutes will be posted on the 91 Project website within 72 hours of meetings.
