Six-Week Closure of Westbound 91 Maple Street Off-Ramp in Corona to Start December 14

The 91 Project in Corona will require a full closure of the westbound 91 Maple Street off-ramp in Corona for approximately six weeks, starting December 14 at 8 pm. The closure is needed to allow crews to widen the 91 roadway in this area.

The westbound off-ramps at Serfas Club Drive and Lincoln Avenue are available as detours.

Motorists should allow extra travel time, follow detour signs, and rideshare when possible. Drivers also are reminded that speed limits throughout the construction area are 55 MPH, with fines doubled in construction zones.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
