Nighttime Full Closures of 91 in Corona Set for Sept. 29, 30

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project will require a nighttime full closure of eastbound 91 at Maple Street on Thursday, Sept. 29, followed by a nighttime full closure of westbound 91 at Maple Street on Friday, Sept. 30.

The closure will start both nights at 11:59 pm and be complete by 4 am. Lanes will be reduced approximately one hour before the full closures occur.

Crews will continue working on the support structures for construction of the new Maple Street Bridge.

For the eastbound closure, motorists will exit at Maple Street. As a detour, motorists will exit at Maple Street, turn left on Paseo Grande and re-enter eastbound 91. For the westbound closure, motorists will exit at Maple Street, head north to Pomona Road, head west on Pomona Road and head south to re-enter westbound 91 at Auto Center/Serfas Club Drive.

Motorists should allow extra travel time, follow detour routes, and check real-time traffic information using IE511.org.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open during the first half of 2017.
