91 Project Open House Set for May 14

Residents, business operators, and commuters are invited to attend an Open House on May 14 to learn about significant upcoming construction activities on the 91 Project in Corona and Riverside.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission, the lead agency for the 91 Project, will host the Open House from 6 pm to 8 pm at the Corona Public Library, 650 S. Main St., Corona.

The Open House format will allow visitors to drop by at their convenience to talk to project team members, view exhibits and maps, and learn about upcoming work, including the 10-month closure of the westbound 91 Main Street off-ramp starting May 15, the reduction of lane widths on the 91 between the 71 and Main Street for 10 months, and a 15-month package of work activities associated with the Serfas Club Drive and Maple Street interchanges.

No formal presentation is scheduled during the Open House, but visitors may view a series of 91-second videos about a variety of project topics. Visitors also will be reminded about the importance of driving safely through the project limits.

The construction team is on schedule to open the new express lanes and regular lanes in 2017.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside.
