Main Street and Lincoln Avenue Weekend Ramp Closures

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's (RCTC) 91 Project, weekend nighttime closures of the Main Street and Lincoln Avenue ramps are required to safely allow crews to continue reconstructing the new ramps. Closures and detours are planned as follows:

Westbound 91 Main Street On-Ramp Closures - During these closures, motorists will be detoured to the Maple Street on-ramp.

- Friday, May 13 – 8 pm to 7:30 am
- Saturday, May 14 – 11:59 pm to 8:30 am
- Sunday, May 15 – 9 pm to 4:30 am

Westbound 91 Lincoln Avenue On-Ramp and Off-Ramp Closures - During these closures, motorists will be detoured to the Maple Street ramps.

- Friday, May 13 – 8 pm to 7:30 am
- Saturday, May 14 – 11:59 pm to 8:30 am
- Sunday, May 15 – 9 pm to 4:30 am

Eastbound 91 Lincoln Avenue On-Ramp and Off-Ramp Closures – During these closures, motorists can use the Paseo Grande on-ramp, Maple Street off-ramp or Main Street off-ramp

- Friday, May 13 – 9:30 pm to 8:30 am

Eastbound 91 Main Street Off-Ramp Closures - During these closures, motorists can use the Lincoln Avenue or Maple Street off-ramps

- Saturday, May 14 – 9:30 pm to 8:30 am
- Sunday, May 15 – 9:30 pm to 6:30 am

- MORE -

These closures are subject to change based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.

Motorists are reminded to , allow extra travel time, follow detour signs, carpool or use public transit when possible, and patronize local businesses.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
