E. Grand Blvd. to open Monday; 91 Project Work Will Resume with Ongoing Investigation

The East Grand Boulevard, between Third Street and Joy Street, in the City of Corona will reopen to motorists on Monday, October 12, 2015 at 5:00 a.m. as the area has been secured for the ongoing investigation into the collapse of the temporary support beams that occurred Friday night at about 11 pm. Project work will also resume on Monday after a project-wide stand down to re-emphasize and re-evaluate overall safety procedures.

Seven workers involved in the incident remain hospitalized. Out of respect for the injured workers and their families' privacy, additional information on their condition is unavailable at this time. "The 91 Project Team's thoughts and prayers remain with those injured by this incident and the kind words and offers of support from the community on their behalf is sincerely appreciated" said Anne Mayer, Riverside County Transportation Commission Executive Director.

The cause of the incident is currently under investigation to ensure that safety remains the number one priority for the public, 91 Project, and the men and women who are making these infrastructure improvements.
