#### **Full Closures of Eastbound and Westbound 91 and Lincoln Avenue, Corona**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's (RCTC) 91 Project in Corona will require weeknight full closures of eastbound and westbound 91 at Lincoln Avenue and a weekend full closure of a section of Lincoln Avenue. The following closures are subject to change, based on weather and other factors:

- Full closure of eastbound 91 at Lincoln Avenue, Wednesday, Nov. 16, 10 pm to 4 am
- Full closure of westbound 91 at Lincoln Avenue, Thursday, Nov. 17, 10 pm to 4 am

During these closures, a bypass lane will be in place, allowing motorists to remain on the 91. Motorists should anticipate lane reductions one to two hours prior to the start of the closures and should avoid the area, if possible. Those who cannot avoid the area should allow extra travel time.

- Full closure of a section of Lincoln Avenue between D/Second Street and Pomona Road, Friday, Nov. 18 at 9 pm to Monday, Nov. 21 at 4 am

This closure is the third of three closures in this area to allow crews to repave Lincoln Avenue. The westbound 91 Lincoln Avenue off-ramp also will be closed Friday, Nov. 18 from 10 pm to 6 am and Saturday, Nov. 19 from 11 pm to 7 am.

Throughout the weekend, motorists on D/Second Street may travel east and west through the Lincoln Avenue intersection. All entrances to the Cardenas Shopping Center and McDonald's will be open. Motorists on Pomona Road may travel east and west through the Lincoln Avenue intersection. Southbound motorists on Lincoln Avenue must turn right or left on Pomona Road

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be

made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The project is on schedule to open new lanes by spring 2017.
