### **Eastbound 91 Nighttime Closure Scheduled for May 3-4**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission will require a nighttime full closure of the eastbound 91 between Green River Road and Maple Street in Corona. Crews will begin reducing lanes on Tuesday, May 3 at 10 pm with a full closure of eastbound 91 to follow on Wednesday, May 4 from midnight to 4 am. This closure will allow crews to safely install overhead signs near the 71. This closure is subject to change based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.

During this closure, motorists traveling east will be detoured to the Green River Road off-ramp, east on Palisades Drive, north on Serfas Club Drive, east on Frontage Road to reconnect with eastbound 91 at Paseo Grande.

Motorists are reminded to follow the posted reduced 55-mile per hour speed limit, allow extra travel time, and carpool or use public transit when possible.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
