#### **Eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive On-Ramp to Close for 15 Months**

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) announces that a 15-month full closure of the eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive on-ramp in Corona will begin Tuesday, September 1, 2015.

The ramp closure is part of the 91 Project's "Serfas Club/Maple Makeover" activity that began in June and will continue through late 2016. The closure will allow crews to safely reconstruct a new on-ramp, build retaining walls and construct the temporary and permanent eastbound Maple bridge and off-ramp that will cross beneath the eastbound 91 Maple Street off-ramp. In the area, utility relocation work is continuing along Serfas Club Drive, with lanes reduced to one lane in both directions.

As a detour, motorists can use the new Frontage Road alignment between Serfas Club Drive and Paseo Grande to connect with the new Maple Street/Paseo Grande eastbound on-ramp, which opened August 25. The new alignment of Frontage Road is scheduled to open prior to the closure of the Serfas Club on-ramp. Please see map on page 3.

During the ramp closure and throughout construction, motorists are reminded to allow extra travel time, especially to and from the West Corona Metrolink station, follow detour signs, adjust travel plans to off-peak hours, if possible, and to carpool or use public transit, when feasible. The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express lane connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
