91 Project to Open, Close Ramps at Serfas Club, Maple in Corona

As part of the 91 Project in Corona, the new eastbound 91 Maple Street on-ramp will open, and the adjacent Serfas Club Drive on-ramps and off-ramps will close for construction activity, starting in August. The Riverside County Transportation Commission, which is the lead for the project, is referring to the series of activities occurring in this area as the “Serfas/Maple Makeover,” with work planned through late 2016. Upcoming changes include:

- **Temporary Closure, Westbound 91 Serfas Club Drive Off-Ramp** – This ramp will be closed for two months starting on or about August 10. Motorists can use the Maple Street off-ramp as the detour route.
- **New Ramp Opening, Eastbound 91 Maple Street/Paseo Grande On-Ramp** – The new on-ramp is expected to open and the existing on-ramp is expected to close on or about August 17.
- **Long-Term Closure, Eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive On-Ramp** – This ramp will be closed for approximately 15 months, following the opening of the new Maple Street/Paseo Grande on-ramp. Drivers can use the new on-ramp as the detour route.
- **New Roadway Opening, Frontage Road** – The new alignment of Frontage Road between Serfas Club Drive and Paseo Grande is planned to open in late August.
- **Temporary Closure, Eastbound 91 Serfas Club Drive Off-Ramp** – This ramp will require a weekend closure in mid-September. Motorists can use the Maple Street off-ramp detour route.

91 Project team members will be in the community to answer questions on August 8 from 9 am to 1 pm at both the Ralph’s shopping center at 2661 Green River Road and at the Walmart Neighborhood Market shopping center at 1560 W. Sixth Street.

During the Serfas/Maple Makeover and all phases of 91 Project construction, motorists are reminded to:

- Expect delays and allow extra travel time
- Watch for changing conditions and follow changeable message signs
- Adjust travel plans to off-peak hours, if possible, or use alternate routes
- Carpool or use public transit, when feasible

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
