Nighttime Full Closure of the Westbound 91 at Maple Street in Corona Extended One Additional Night, Aug. 8

The Riverside County Transportation Commission's (RCTC) 91 Project will require the full closure of westbound 91 at Maple Street in Corona for an additional night from what was previously scheduled. The roadway will be closed from Monday, August 8 at 10 PM to Tuesday, August 9 at 4 AM. This closure will allow crews to continue to safely remove the temporary support structure from the Maple Street Bridge over the 91.

Motorists will be directed to exit Maple Street, head north to Pomona Road and follow Pomona Road west to Auto Center/Serfas Club Drive to re-enter westbound 91.

During these closures, drivers are reminded to plan ahead, allow extra travel time, follow detour signs, and avoid the area, if possible.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open during the first half of 2017.
